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Lessons are \$45.00 when the student is on the weekly or bi-weekly schedule paid at the beginning of each month. Drop-in lessons, or occasional lessons, are \$55.00 each. Drop-in lessons will be paid for before the lesson takes place. Most lessons are private, but semi-privates are also widely used. I keep it at two riders at a time in most cases, but will occasionally work with three in a group.

24 hour notice for cancellations is required. Cancellations within 24 hours will not be refunded. Make-up lessons will be scheduled at Beth's discretion and will take place within two weeks of the missed lesson. No make-ups will be offered for no-shows or taking lessons away from a child as punishment. Lessons missed due to a student needing to study for a test or make up school work will not be made up. Cancellations due to sudden illness or emergency will be able to be made up.

Lessons canceled due to weather conditions or otherwise canceled by the instructor will be made up. Our footing drains very well, so it is safe to ride after a heavy rain in most cases. In the event of rain, if conditions permit, the lesson may consist of unmounted horsemanship education in the barn.

Every rider will wear a certified, properly fitted helmet at all times when mounted – no exceptions! I can lend a helmet for riders first starting to ride, but please purchase your own by the second month of lessons. Saddle Up Tack and Feed on Highway 27 has a selection of safe helmets.

No open toed shoes, flip-flops, or sandals are to be worn in the barn.

Riders will need hard soled boots, preferably leather, with a 1-2 inch heel.

Do not walk in the pastures unaccompanied by Beth or a person appointed by her. Our horses are very well-behaved and sweet, but the behavior of any horse can be sudden and unpredictable.
